A Day in Honduras...

Participate in a project to help a local community build a new school for their children! Here is an example of a typical day on the trip:

7:00 am – Breakfast as a team.

8:00 am – Travel to the community.

8:30 am – Paint, build a playground, plant trees, pour concrete sidewalks, stucco and more.

12:00 pm – PB&J lunch on the work site.

1:00 pm – Work & play! Make time for a soccer game or jump rope with the kids.

3:00 pm – Have a snack on the way back to the lodge. One day stop by a local tourist attraction or waterfall.

6:00 pm – Dinner as a team and team meeting to prepare for the next day.

7:00 pm – Rest and relaxation.



Lodging & Transportation

Team members will fly together from Houston or LA into San Pedro Sula, Honduras. After arriving in Honduras, the team will travel by private vehicle to the lodge.

Team members will sleep in 1 to 3 person cabins with twin beds and indoor bathrooms. There is electricity and running water, though only bottled water should be used for drinking and brushing. Each day, the team will eat breakfast and dinner in the dining room. We will pack lunches each morning to bring to the work sites.

During the day, the team will travel to and from the work site in vehicles driven by local drivers with extensive knowledge of the area. On the last night of the trip, the team will stay in a nice hotel in San Pedro Sula to celebrate their accomplishments.

Safety & Security

The team will be led by our experienced Honduran staff and accompanied by a SCW: USA founder or staff member, veteran trip members, and private security as needed. Team members will travel and work in groups at all times.

During the days, the team will be working in rural villages, 2-3 hours from the nearest city of San Pedro Sula. While on site, SCW takes all necessary precautions to ensure that team members are safe and comfortable. The team will have plenty of water and a first aid kit at all times. In case of injury, there is a medical clinic in the nearby town and full, modern hospitals in San Pedro Sula.

Trip Costs

Trip costs is \$2,000 for the June trip plus a suggested donation of \$500 to the school project. This includes airfare, lodging, meals and local transportation.
